Robert Dishner is a Senior Portfolio Manager responsible for distressed investments. Since joining Stark in 2003, Robert has had the roles of Head of Equities for the Americas and Europe, co-Head of Emerging Markets, where he oversaw equity, corporate, sovereign, currency and local markets trading in the region, and Senior Distressed Trading Analyst. Robert was the lead analyst in many of the Firm's largest restructuring positions, including United Airlines, Telecom Argentina (Latin America's biggest distressed restructuring) and Worldcom/MCI. Additionally, he has supported other event-based trading strategies, including Risk Arbitrage, Commodities and Global Macro. Prior to joining Stark, Robert was a U.S. High Yield Healthcare Analyst at UBS Warburg and also worked within the Leveraged Finance Restructuring Advisory area. From 1995 until 2000, he worked at Chilmark Partners (Zell/Chilmark Fund and Chilmark Partners Fund II), a private equity/advisory firm focused on financially distressed companies. Previously, Robert worked in GE Capital's Corporate Finance division, where he was responsible for underwriting bank loans for companies principally entering or exiting Chapter 11.
