**2005.** This year, 23 candidates were invited to meet Instituto Ling Directors on a group interview, from which 9 were selected to join our community. **In 2005, Instituto Ling has outdone the sum of US\$1 million invested and 67 scholarships granted.**

## How to apply

**Basic requirements.** To hold a Brazilian citizenship, presenting the acceptance letter from a top international school and to demonstrate financial need.

**Universities.** Carnegie Mellon University, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Duke, Harvard, INSEAD, IU Bloomington, MIT, Northwestern, NYU, Stanford, UC Berkeley, UCLA, UNC Chapel Hill, Cambridge, Chicago, London, Michigan, Oxford, Pennsylvania, Texas at Austin. **Instituto Ling scholarships are offered to the top MBA and LLM courses in United States and Europe.**
