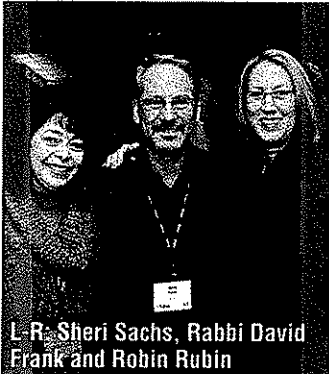


## Temple Solel Leaders Attend Program at Northwestern
