#### Admissions:

Application deadline is March 1, 2014. Admission decisions will be made by March 31, 2014. Application decisions for those applying early will be made as applications are received.

#### **Health Insurance:**

It is expected that participants have their own health insurance, valid in the United States. For international participants, evidence of health care coverage of major medical up to \$100,000 is required. Alternatively, participants can purchase health care coverage for \$25 per week for the duration of the program. You must furnish proof of insurance in English.

#### Housing:

International participants must demostrate evidence of U.S. \$3,000 accessible for living expenses while in the program required in the form of a letter from a bank.

#### Payment:

A deposit of \$1,000 is payable upon admission; the remainder is due by September 1, 2014. The remaining tuition may be paid via check in US dollars written on a US bank, or via wire transfer. Contact DRRC with questions about payment.

#### Cancellations:

A full refund will be given in the event of a cancellation made on or before July 15, 2014. Cancellations after July 15, 2014 will incur a 50% reduction in a refund of the deposit.
