Major gifts on the part of individuals are defined as those in excess of \$10,000. Reports to the Senior Director of Fund Development at By The Hand Club.

Major Responsibilities

- Works with the Senior Director of Fund Development to create fund development strategies to increase revenue from existing individual donors and secure new major donors.
- Develops and manages timelines for various fundraising activities to ensure strategic plans and critical fund raising processes are carried out in a timely manner.



- Monitors and evaluates all fundraising activities to ensure that the fundraising goals are being achieved.
- Grows major donor database through referrals from current BTH major donors, networking and other methods.
- Builds relationships with individuals in order to advance the mission and fundraising goals of the organization.
- Helps cultivate relationships with churches to engage potential major donors.
- Leverages the Spring Benefit to engage individual donors with major wealth in By The Hand Club e.g. assists in inviting qualified individuals to serve as Table Hosts or to attend.
- Plans and oversees connection-type events in individual donor homes to expand network and deepen relationship with major wealth individuals.
- Prepares and presents to Senior Director of Fund Development regular reports on progress of fundraising goals.
- Engages volunteers for special fund development projects.
- Monitors trends and best practices in order to adapt fundraising strategies as necessary.
