After admission, financial assistance may be provided in the form of student loans by completing the financial aid process. Please complete the 2020-2021 University Aid Application in full. Do not leave any fields blank. If your answer to a question that requires a dollar amount is \$0, please enter a 0. Leaving this information blank may cause delays in the processing of your financial aid application.

Returning Students: Please provide your gross earnings from your summer internship.

If you are borrowing federal education loans, you are required to complete the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please indicate the date on which you submitted your FAFSA to the federal processor in your University Aid Application. If you have not yet completed the FAFSA, please do so by the preferred deadline.

International Students

Please complete the 2020-2021 University Aid Application in full. Do not leave any fields blank. If your answer to a question that requires a dollar amount is \$0, please enter a 0. International students should provide the name of their selected lender on page 5 of the University Aid Application.

Household Information

Household information is required by the Office of Financial Aid for completing our financial need analysis and to determine if additional information is needed for the financial aid file.

If you are engaged and will be married on or before 12/1/2020, please complete the section for your (prospective) spouse's information. If your (prospective) spouse will be enrolled as a half-time or full-time student, please provide the name of the college/university he/she will attend. Please list all legal dependents who will be living with you while you attend Kellogg.

Outside Scholarship Assistance

If you have been awarded a scholarship from an outside source or through an agency or organization other than Kellogg, please provide the name of the scholarship and the amount awarded in the space provided in this section.

Other Anticipated Financial Resources

If you are receiving financial assistance from your parents or relatives, please provide the amount of their contribution. It is important to confirm this amount with your parents or relatives first because the amount listed in this section becomes part of your financial aid resources.

If you are receiving tuition reimbursement from your employer, please state the amount you will receive for the academic year.

If there are other resources you are receiving, please state the amount, source, and explain briefly in the section provided in this section.

Student (and Spouse Gross) Income

Please provide your current gross annual earnings from work. Include annual bonus, if applicable.
