- 3. Select the 2022 aid year

## **Borrowing from Northwestern University (Northwestern Loan):**

- If you selected the Northwestern International Loan, you are accepting the loan by electronically signing the financial aid offer.
- Complete the 2021-2022 online application for the loan through CAESAR by navigating to the Financial Aid tile, then selecting Institutional Loan Application from the left hand navigation. The amount you are eligible to borrow is reflected on your financial aid notification.
- Once you are approved for the loan and the promissory notes are ready, the Student Finance Office will contact you (via a message sent to your Kellogg email address) with instructions to sign the promissory notes.

## Private Education Loans (Other than Northwestern Loan):

- Students who wish to borrow a private education loan should apply for the loan directly through the private lender.
- Once the lender has approved the loan, the student should send the name of the lender and the approved loan amount to the Kellogg Financial Aid Office at <u>finaid@kellogg.northwestern.edu</u>.

## • Returning Students:

If you borrowed a private education loan or Grad PLUS Loan in your first year at Kellogg, your 2021-2022 financial aid award letter will reflect the same loan option and lender you selected for 2020-2021.
