This interface synchronizes Video Episodes with transcript text, PDF documents, spreadsheets, graphics, animations, websites, other videos, and a host of other transmedia resources. The result is a richer learning experience that you control.

System Requirements

The TELLING STORY Player is designed to run in virtually any modern operating system and browser combination. Using this course requires that you are using a recent PC or Macintosh computer with an HTML5-compatible browser. As with any media-rich online course, the faster your Internet connection, the better. If you experience any difficulties in performance, try connecting from another location with better Internet speeds.

Operating systems:

- Mac OS X v10.7 or higher
- Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 10
- iOS version 6 or higher
- Android version 4.1 ("Jellybean") or higher

Browsers:

- Google Chrome, Stable Channel: Chrome supports a variety of release channels with major updates about every 6 weeks. We recommend staying on the "Stable Channel" which has been fully tested and has the blessing of the google support team. <u>More</u> <u>Information and Download</u>
- Firefox, Currently Supported Version: Firefox is automatically configured to check for updates as new stable versions are released. We recommend keeping Firefox up to date by using the currently supported version. <u>More Information and Download</u>
