

San Francisco Immersion Quarter

Kellogg's San Francisco Immersion Quarter is a dynamic experiential learning opportunity for students interested in venture capital and entrepreneurship. Students live in the Bay Area for the duration of the program while taking courses taught by Kellogg faculty and completing a part-time internship.

Internship Component

Purpose: Provide students with professional interests and personal experience in innovation,

entrepreneurship, and/or venture capital an opportunity to work in a growth-stage startup

or venture capital firm.

Eligibility: This highly selective program is open to MBA students in the full-time program and part-

time program. To be considered for admission, students must have completed their core

courses and an advanced course in finance.

Duration: Part-time (20 hours/week) during the Winter Quarter (January – mid-March, 2022).

Students are able to work on-site Monday – Wednesday and are in class Thursday – Friday

at Northwestern's San Francisco satellite campus.

Compensation: Students will receive course credit for their internships, but we understand California's internship laws may make it easier to also provide a stipend.

Process:

- Students are admitted to the program in June and in late September.
- Companies receive resume book of participants interested in VC or startups by early October.
- Companies reach out to candidates of interest and coordinate interviews during October and November.
- Companies extend offers by end of November. Final selection of an intern is solely at the discretion of the company.
- Students on-site and available to begin working by the first week of January.

Additional information:

- Reviewing resumes does not create any obligation to hire.
- Companies may interview multiple candidates and make multiple offers (please discuss ability to hire more than one student with Kellogg staff upon indicating interest to review resume book).
- At this time, we expect the Immersion Program will be in-person; we will continue to monitor the pandemic's development as the year progresses.
