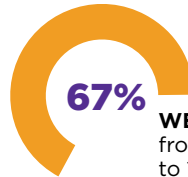

- Two essays
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended
- In-person interview
- Two letters of recommendation
- \$185 application fee
- Official GMAT, GRE, EA, MCAT, or LSAT test scores
 - If you graduated with an undergraduate GPA of 3.4 or greater with a degree in business, economics or STEM-related area from an accredited institution, you are eligible to apply without a test score.*
