

 - But with a memory! It will minimize the number of times the same students are in the same groups!




In this example we are using the Carter Racing exercise.





Carter Racing calls for groups of three, so with our class list of 36 students, we would want 12 groups.








- You can download the resulting groups into Excel and format as needed.






 - You can also change the groupings around however you want





There's also a feature called the Relationship Matrix...




The Relationship Matrix...

... will show you how often the students have negotiated with each other






