START IN

JUNE

Start in June then merge with the second-year Two-Year MBA students in September. Graduate in June — one year after beginning the program.

Two-Year MBA

IDEAL FOR: students who want to gain a deeper knowledge of their current field or are looking to switch careers.

Program highlights

- Truly immersive experience that allows students to take a deep dive into their coursework and pursue an internship to position themselves for a new career
- Students have the flexibility to chart their own paths through a wide range of electives, experiential learning opportunities and global options

START IN

AUGUST

Start in August and graduate in June — two years after beginning the program.

MMM

IDEAL FOR: students with a passion for tackling complex problems by using a holistic approach to innovation.

Program highlights

- Dual-degree program with the Segal Design Institute comprised of coursework leveraging a creative studio culture model that encourages analytical thinking, exploration and action
- Students utilize a human-centered approach and hands-on design thinking methods to address real world challenges
- Grads learn to create opportunities, identify the right problems and lead organizations to solve them well

TWO YEARS

TO COMPLETE

START IN JUNE

Start in June then merge with the first-year Two-Year MBA students in August. Graduate in June — two years after beginning the program.

JD-MBA

IDEAL FOR: students interested in becoming business leaders with legal expertise, or law professionals with a foundation in management.

Program highlights

- Dual-degree program with the Pritzker School of Law that combines academic grounding, analytical skills and practical insights, so students can succeed in law and business
- Students earn an MBA from Kellogg and a JD from Pritzker Law in the short span of three years rather than the five it would take to complete both degrees separately

THREE YEARS

TO COMPLETE

START IN

AUGUST

Start in August and spend the first year at the law school. Spend the second year at Kellogg in Evanston with the incoming Two-Year MBA class and the third year taking electives at both schools.

MBAi

IDEAL FOR: students interested in the intersection between technology and business who come from strong technical backgrounds.

Program highlights

- Earn an Al-focused MBA from Kellogg and the McCormick School of Engineering
- Integrated leadership and technology curriculum creates technically literate executives capables of leading Al-driven businesses
- Program includes a full-time summer internship and optional industry engagement opportunities

1.5 YEARS

TO COMPLETE

START IN

AUGUST

Start in August and complete in March of the following year — five quarters after beginning the program.




OF FULL-TIME GRADUATES RECEIVED JOB OFFERS BY THREE MONTHS POST-GRADUATION
